LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in November of 2013.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures and ramp closures at the junction of State Route 20 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Bell Road to the Nevada County line: Southbound motorists can expect the #2 lane closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer counties) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.
