SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday December 29, 2013 – January 4, 2014

Most traffic-interfering work will be limited on Tuesday, December 31 through Wednesday night, January 1 for the New Year's holiday.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. <u>This project</u> <u>is now complete</u>

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Bell Road to Lorenson Road/Florence Lane:
Motorists can expect the southbound #2 lane and right shoulder closed from 8 p.m. to
6 a.m. Sunday and Monday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.
