LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. <u>This project is now complete</u>

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra counties) from Marysville Road to Coyoteville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do crack seal work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the West Towle Road overhead to Alta Road: Motorists can expect various westbound lane restrictions from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do pavement grinding work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the chain-on area to Alta Road: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do pavement grinding work.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada counties) from about one mile west of the State Route 20 junction to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday and Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail repair.
