LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. *This project is now complete*

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Dow Road to Willow Valley Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from South Wolf Creek to Combie Road/Wolf Road: Motorists can expect #2 and right shoulders closed from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at State Route 20/W, Empire Street: Northbound motorists can expect a full off-ramp closure from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.



State Route 49 (Placer County) from Masters Court/Golden Chain to the Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect the south and northbound #3 lanes closed from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.
