## SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday February 9 – February 15, 2014

## LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. <u>This project</u> <u>is now complete</u>

## SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**State Route 49** (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7:45 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Wednesday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect #2 and right shoulders closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**State Route 49** (Yuba and Sutter Counties) from Marysville Road to Ladies Canyon: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to State Route 193: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane restrictions from 7:30 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
