**Sunday through Saturday**  
**May 25 – May 31, 2014**

**Most traffic interfering work will be limited from Friday, May 23 through Monday, May 26 for the Memorial Day Weekend.**

**LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level. Construction is expected to begin in late June.

**SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: Westbound motorists can expect a full highway closure from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Thursday and Friday**. **State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: All motorists can expect various lane and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Thursday and Friday**. **State Route 49** (El Dorado and Placer County) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7:30**



**a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #2 lane closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Alta to Drum Forebay: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #2 lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Gold Run to State Route 193: Westbound Motorists can expect various lane closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 89** (Placer and Nevada Counties) from West River Drive to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect the #1 lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
