

SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

June 1 – June7, 2014

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level. Construction is expected to begin in late June.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer County) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #2 lane closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Carlton Flat Campground to the Caltrans Downieville Maintenance Station: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 8:45 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Yuba Gap to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to guardrail work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Alta to Drum Forebay: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #2 lanes closed from 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 89 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from West River Drive to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect the #1 lanes closed from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Wednesday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 89 (Placer Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge to West River Drive: Motorists can expect the #1 lanes closed from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do shoulder work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) at Somerset Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 267 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from the Truckee River to the Ranger's Station: Motorists can expect lane restrictions from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Tuesday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do shoulder work.
