LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level. Construction is expected to begin in mid July.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: Motorists can expect a full highway closure from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday. State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #2 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.
