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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday, June 29-July 5, 2014

NOTE: Most traffic-interfering work will be limited from **5 a.m. Thursday, July 3 to 8 p.m. Monday, July 7** because of the Fourth of July holiday.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level. Construction is expected to begin in mid July.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: Motorists can expect a full highway closure and the Idaho-Maryland and Brunswick Road on- and off-ramps closed from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. The Idaho-Maryland ramps will also be closed from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work and roadway excavation. A detour will be available. State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Cedar Song Road to Independence Trail: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Rams Horn Campground to Yuba Pass Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7:45 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to clean ditches.





Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Drum Forebay Road to Alta Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect the #2 lane and shoulder closed from **6 p.m. to 11 a.m. Sunday through Wednesday** and from **7 p.m. Wednesday to 5 a.m. Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to pour concrete.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Kingvale to Donner Pass Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures at various locations from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage repairs.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the junction with State Route 193 to Gold Run: Eastbound motorists can expect the #3 lane closed at various locations from **8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do maintenance.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at State Route 49: Motorists can expect the southbound State Route 49 connector ramp to westbound I-80 closed from **9 a.m. to noon Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guard rail repair.

State Route 89 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from West River Street to Donner Creek: Northbound and southbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
