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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE
Sunday through Saturday, September 21 - 27, 2014

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.

August 1 through October 31

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (Exit 139): Westbound motorists can expect a long-term closure of the on and off-ramps from **August 1 through October 31**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work. **Motorists are advised to Secret Town interchange as the alternate route.**

September 14 - 19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Penryn Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

September 21 - 26

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Magra Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday, Monday, Thursday, & Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

September 23 - 24





Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Bell Road to State Route 20: Motorists can expect a full highway closure from **10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do lift the Magra overcrossing bridge deck. ***A detour is available using the State Route 20/49 corridor. This is a 56 mile detour and motorists should expect strict CHP speed enforcement. All westbound commercial vehicles are subject to CHP inspection and escort during the detour.***

September 23 - 24

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Magra Road: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. (before and after the full closure) Tuesday and Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

September 21 – October 13

Interstate 80 (Placer County) on Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (local roadway): Motorists can expect a full closure of the local overcrossing of Interstate 80 from **September 21 through October 13**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Brunswick to Idaho Maryland Road: Motorists can expect various lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday, Thursday & Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Slate Range Road to Gold Lake Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7:15 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Indian Flat Road to Old Downieville Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm-Harrison Street to Joeger Road: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to paving and sweeping work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Fiberboard undercrossing to the Truckee Scales: Motorists can expect the eastbound #1 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.





Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from end of Chain on area to the Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect the eastbound #1 lane closed from **8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Floriston to Hinton: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Vista Point to Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **5 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Acid Flats to Farad: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #2 lanes closed from **5 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Calpine Summit to the Plumas County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Webber Lake to Cottonwood Creek Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 267 (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Soaring Way/Brockway Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
