LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work has begun on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.

August 1 - October 31

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (Exit 139): Westbound motorists can expect a long-term closure of the on- and off-ramps from **August 1 through October 31** for miscellaneous structure work. Motorists are advised to use Secret Town interchange as the alternate route.

<u>September 21 – October 13</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer County) on Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (local roadway): Motorists can expect a full closure of the local overcrossing of Interstate 80 from **September 21 through October 13** for miscellaneous structure work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at Holcomb Drive/Cherry Creek Road: Motorists can expect various lane restrictions from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday** for striping work.

State Route 89 (Nevada/Sierra County) from Sagehen Creek to Sagehen Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday** for maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Old State Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday** for tree work.

State Route 267 (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Soaring Way/Brockway Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. and from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sunday through Saturday for bridge work.
