## **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work has begun on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.
