**Sierra Roadwork Schedule**  
**Sunday through Saturday, October 26 - November 1, 2014**

**LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.

**Oct. 26-29**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Brace Road overcrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Wednesday** for K-rail installation.

**Oct. 26-Nov. 1**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Penryn Road overcrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday and 10 p.m. Friday to 7 a.m. Saturday** for bridge work.

**Oct. 26-Nov. 1**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Magra Road overcrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work.

**SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**





**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Scotts Flat Road to Conservation Vista: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** for utility work.

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Alpha Road to Bear River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday and Tuesday** for maintenance work.

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) at Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday** for bridge work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada/Placer County) from Combie Road/Wolf Road to Dry Creek Road: Northbound and southbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures at various locations from **7 p.m. Sunday to 6 a.m. Monday** for striping.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Newtown Road to Rush Creek Way/Delphine Lane: Motorists can expect one-way-traffic control at various locations from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday** for utility work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Hulbert Way to Kemper/New Airport Road: Northbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for sewer work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra/Yuba County) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for maintenance work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from Vista Point to the Donner Lake undercrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 7 a.m. to noon Friday** for striping.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge in Truckee to Mystic Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 7 a.m. to noon Friday** for grinding and striping work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada/Sierra County) from the Sierra County line to the Nevada County line: Eastbound motorists can expect the #2 lane closed from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for guardrail repair work.





**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Taylor Road undercrossing in Roseville: Westbound motorists can expect the on-ramp closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday** for maintenance.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from the junction with State Route 65 to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 p.m. Sunday to 7 a.m. Monday** for striping.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Calpine Summit to the Plumas County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for ditch cleaning.

**State Route 267** (Placer County) from Airport Road/Schaffer Mill to the junction with State Route 28 in Kings Beach: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for maintenance work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
