LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level. Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Penryn Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Wednesday and from 10 p.m. Friday to 7 a.m. Saturday for bridge work. State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect ramp and lane closures from **10 p.m. Sunday to 7 a.m. Monday** for landscaping and striping work on the Dorsey Drive Interchange project.
