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**Sierra Roadwork Schedule,
Sunday through Saturday, December 7-13, 2014**

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. Dec. 7-13

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from King Road to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work.

Dec. 7-13

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Horseshoe Bar Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday and 10 p.m. Friday to 7 a.m. Saturday** for bridge work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Idaho-Maryland Road to Brunswick Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday** for striping and drainage work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Scotts Flat Road to Conservation Vista: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Saturday** for utility work.





Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Taylor Road in Roseville: Westbound motorists can expect the on-ramp closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday** for a maintenance operation.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to the junction with State Route 193: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday** for drainage cleaning.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Rattlesnake Road to Somerset Drive: Motorists can expect the right shoulder closed from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
