**Sierra Roadwork Schedule,  
 Sunday through Saturday, December 14-20, 2014**

**LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Cameo Drive to just south of Lime Kiln Road: Northbound motorists can expect the right shoulder closed from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday** for utility work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at Taylor Road in Roseville: Westbound motorists can expect the on-ramp closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday** for a city maintenance operation.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Applegate Road to Dry Creek Road: Westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **11 a.m. Monday to 3 a.m. Tuesday** for electrical work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
