# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, January 25-31, 2015

## **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. ### <u>Jan. 25-31</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn, Gilardi and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

# Jan. 25-Feb. 9

Brace Road Overcrossing (Placer County) Motorists can expect the overcrossing closed from Sunday, January 25 through Monday, February 9.

#### Jan. 27-28

Interstate 80 (Placer County) between Sierra College Boulevard and State Route 193 junction; Motorists can expect full highway closure with an eight-mile detour from 11 p.m. Tuesday to 5 a.m. Wednesday. The interstate will be closed again from 11 p.m. Wednesday, January 28 until 5 a.m. Thursday for the raising of the Brace Road Overcrossing.



## **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

**State Route 49** (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Coyoteville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday for crack seal work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) Eastbound Ramp to State Route S 267/89 North: Eastbound motorists can expect a full off-ramp closure from **Wednesday 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.** for pavement repair.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Floriston Way to Mystic Road: East and Westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 65 junction to State Route 193: Eastbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday for bridge work.
