# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, April 26-May 2

## **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. # April 26-May 2

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

# April 26-May 2

Horseshoe Bar Road Overcrossing (Placer County) in Loomis: Motorists can expect the overcrossing closed from Sunday, April 19 through Wednesday May 6.

# April 26-May 2

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect the eastbound Interstate 80 on and off ramps will be closed at Weimar Cross Road in Placer County from **Sunday April 19 through May 22** as part of the "Raise 80" vertical clearance project. Eastbound Interstate 80 will be restricted to one lane



for approximately three-quarters of a mile under the overcrossing from **May 10** through **May 22**.

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

### April 26-May2

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures in both north and southbound lanes **around the clock April 26 through May 1** for striping operations and roadway excavation.

# **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Putts Lake Undercrossing to the Drum Forebay/Nyack Overcrossing: Motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday April 27 through Thursday April 30 for maintenance operations.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Soda Springs overcrossing of Donner Lake Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures on the overcrossing from 12:01a.m. Monday April 27 through 2 p.m. Friday May 1 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada County) from Hinton Road to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect lane closures 7 a.m. Monday April 27 through midnight Wednesday April 29 and Thursday April 30 from 7 a.m. to midnight for loop installation.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Hinton Road to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect lane closures from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday April 22 through Thursday April 30 for grinding operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Farad Undercrossing/Mystic Road to the Sierra County line: Motorists can expect lane closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday April 27 through Thursday April 30 for shoulder work.



Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Floriston interchange to the Farad Undercrossing/Mystic Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday April 28 through Wednesday April 29 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the State Route 193 interchange to the Union Pacific Railroad trestle: Motorists can expect lane closures from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday April 27 through Thursday April 30 for maintenance operations.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to Junction Highway 49 North: Motorists can expect alternating traffic control from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 26 through Thursday April 22 for crack seal operations.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Turner Canyon Creek to Junction Highway 49 South: Motorists can expect alternating traffic control from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 27 through Thursday April 30 for crack seal operations.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Rams Horn Campground to Mountain House Road/Goodyear Creek Road: Motorists can expect to be held in both directions 10 minutes or more from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 27, Wednesday April 29 and Thursday April 30 for blasting activity.

**State Route 49** (Yuba/Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Rocky Rest Campground: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 27 through Thursday April 30** for ditch cleaning.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
