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# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, May 3-9

### **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. ## **May 3-9**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

## May 3-9

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect the eastbound Interstate 80 on and off ramps will be closed at Weimar Cross Road in Placer County from **Sunday April 19 through May 22** as part of the "Raise 80" vertical clearance project. Eastbound Interstate 80 will be restricted to one lane for approximately three-quarters of a mile under the overcrossing from **May 10** through **May 22**.

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR



89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

## May 3-9

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures in both north and southbound lanes **around the clock from 7 a.m. Monday May 4 through 6 a.m. Friday May 8** for shoulder work and roadway excavation.

#### **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Whitmore Maintenance Station to the Putts Lake Undercrossing: Motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for maintenance operations.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Nevada County line to the Soda Springs overcrossing of Donner Lake Road: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures 7 a.m. Monday May 4 through 11 a.m. Friday May 8 for roadway excavation.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Truckee River Bridge #12 to Hinton Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 6 a.m. Monday May 4 through 6 a.m. Friday May 8 for loop installation.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Floriston to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect lane closures from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for grinding operations.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada County) from Donner Pass Road to Crystal Lake Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Hwy 193 interchange to the Union Pacific Railroad Trestle before Auburn: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for maintenance operations.



Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Floriston interchange to the Farad Undercrossing/Mystic Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday May 4 through Friday May 8 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) from the Donner Pass Road interchange to the Kingvale Undercrossing: Motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures at various locations from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for drainage work.

State Route 89 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Coloma Road to Downieville Maintenance Station: Motorists can expect alternating traffic control from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday May 4 through Thursday May 7 for ditch cleaning.

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from .50 mile past Lowell Hill Road to the Bear River overcrossing: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday May 4** for drainage work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
