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## Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, May 24-30

### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. #### May 24-30

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect temporary, alternating lane closures starting **Tuesday, May 26 from 7 pm. to 9 a.m.** for bridge work. Westbound traffic will not be affected.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at King Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect the overcrossing to be closed from **Sunday May 31 through Saturday June 20** as part of the "Raise 80" vertical clearance project. Interstate 80 will be closed **11 p.m. Tuesday, June 2 until 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 3. The Interstate will close again from 11 p.m. Wednesday, June 3, until approximately 5 a.m. Thursday June 4** to lift the overcrossing.

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

**May 24-30**

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from **6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday May 18 through Thursday** for roadway excavation.

**SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) from the Boca Bridge and Hirschdale onramp to EB Floriston onramp: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 p.m. to Noon Tuesday May 26 through Thursday May 28** for grinding work.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) from the Hinton Road undercrossing to the Acid Flat Bridge over the Truckee River: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for grinding work.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) from the Hinton Road undercrossing to the Truckee River bridge: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **5 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for grinding work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) at the Floriston Road interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closure of both east and westbound ramps from **10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for grinding work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closure of both east and westbound ramps from **10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for grinding work.





**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from the Floriston interchange to the Farad Undercrossing/Mystic Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for bridge work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Bell Road to Cameo Drive: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for utility work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Elm Avenue/Fulwiler Avenue to Borland Street/Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Tuesday May 26 through Saturday May 30** for utility work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Rocky Rest Campground to Cemetery Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday May 26 through Thursday May 28** for ditch cleaning.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Antelope Valley Road to Hill Street: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday May 26 through Thursday May 28** for crack seal operations.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from the Cold Creek Campground to Old Truckee Road south: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to Noon Wednesday, May 27** for core drilling.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
