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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, May 31 – June 6

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. More information on the project is available at www.raise80.com

May 31 - June 6

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect temporary, alternating lane closures starting Tuesday, May 26 from 7 pm. to 9 a.m. for bridge work. Westbound traffic will not be affected.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at King Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect the overcrossing to be closed from Sunday May 31 through Saturday June 20 as part of the "Raise 80" vertical clearance project. Interstate 80 will be closed 11 p.m. Tuesday, June 2 until 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 3. The Interstate will close again from 11 p.m. Wednesday, June 3, until approximately 5 a.m. Thursday June 4 to lift the overcrossing.



State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

May 31 - June 6

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday June 1 through Thursday June 4 for roadway excavation.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – (Nevada County) from the Boca Bridge and Hirschdale onramp to WB Floriston onramp and from the Hinton Road undercrossing to the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday June 2 through Saturday June 6 for crack seal operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Floriston interchange to the Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m. on Thursday June 4 for shoulder work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge to the Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7 p.m. to Noon Monday June 1 and Tuesday June 2 for crack seal operations.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Floriston Road interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closure of both east and westbound ramps from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday June 2 through Wednesday June 3** for crack seal operation.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closure of both east and westbound ramps from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday June 2 and Wednesday June 3** for crack seal operations.

Interstate 80 -- Eastbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) at the Kingvale on and off ramps: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures with one way traffic control 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Tuesday June 2 through Saturday June 6 for roadway excavation.



Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) from the Kingvale overcrossing to the Soda Springs overcrossing: Motorists can expect up to 15 minute delays 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Tuesday June 2 through Saturday June 6 for roadway excavation.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Sierra/Nevada Counties) from the Nevada State line to the Sierra County line: Motorists can expect #2 lane and right shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday June 3 for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Donner Lake Undercrossing to the Placer County line in Kingvale: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday June 1 through Thursday June 4 for shoulder work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Bell Road to Cameo Drive: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday June 1 through Saturday June 6** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm Avenue/Fulwiler Avenue to Borland Street/Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday June 1 through Saturday June 6 for utility work.

State Route 49 -- Southbound (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to Wolf Road/Combie Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder restrictions from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday June 1 through Saturday June 6 for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Rocky Rest Campground to Ladies Canyon: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday June 1 through Thursday June 4 for ditch cleaning.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada Counties) from West River Street to Junction Interstate 80/89S: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday June 1 through Wednesday June 3 for striping work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
