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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, June 7 – June 13

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. More information on the project is available at www.raise80.com

<u>June 5 – June 13</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect temporary, alternating lane closures starting Tuesday, May 26 from 7 pm. to 9 a.m. for bridge work. Westbound traffic will not be affected.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at King Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect the overcrossing to be closed from **Sunday May 31 through Saturday June 20** as part of the "Raise 80" vertical clearance project.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.



<u>June 5 – June 13</u>

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday June 7 through Friday June 12 for roadway excavation.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – (Nevada County) between the Boca Bridge and Hirschdale onramp to Floriston onramps: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures for eastbound from 7 p.m. to Noon and westbound from 5 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday June 7 through Saturday June 12 for grinding operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Soda Springs overcrossing: Motorists can expect up to 20 minute delays 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday June 9 through Friday June 12 for roadway excavation.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect right lane and both right and left shoulder closures from 7a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday June 8 through Thursday June 11 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Crystal Lake Road at Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect right lane and both right and left shoulder closures from 7a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday June 8 through Thursday June 11 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the East Cisco undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday June 10 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Yuba Gap/State Route 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 9 a.m. through 4 p.m. Monday and Tuesday June 8 and 9 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 -- Eastbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) at the Kingvale on and off ramps: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures with one way traffic control 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Monday June 8 through Friday June 12 for roadway excavation.



State Route 49 (Placer County) from Bell Road to Cameo Drive: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday June 8 through Friday June 12** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm Avenue/Fulwiler Avenue to Borland Street/Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday June 8 through Saturday June 13 for utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) at Joeger Road: Motorists can expect intermittent full highway closure from **4:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. on Sunday June 7** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Jim Crow Canyon Creek Road to the Sierra County line Oak Valley Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday June 8 through Thursday June 11 for ditch cleaning.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
