Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, June 28 – July 4

Most traffic interfering work will be limited between Thursday, July 2 through Sunday, July 5 due to the 4th of July Holiday

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. June 28 – July 4

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from **6 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday June 29 through Thursday July 2** for roadway excavation.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – (Nevada County) between Hinton Road and Floriston: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures Eastbound from **6 p.m. to 9 a.m.** and Westbound from **5 p.m. to Noon Monday June 29 through Thursday July 2** for grinding operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Kingvale Onramp: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **Midnight Monday June 29 through 6 a.m. Thursday July 2** for highway construction.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Farad undercrossing to the Floriston off ramp: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to Noon Monday June 29 through Wednesday July 1** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – (Placer County) at the Illinoistown Overcrossing at Canyon Way and South Auburn Street/Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect alternating **daytime** and **overnight** overcrossing lane and freeway ramp closures **5 a.m. Monday June 29 through 6 a.m. Thursday July 2** for roadway excavation and bridge work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Rio Oso Road to SR 49 / SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday June 29 through Thursday July 2** for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday June 29 through 6 a.m. Thursday July 2** for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Brandy City Road to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday June 29 through Thursday July 2** for ditch cleaning.

Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
