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# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, August 16 – August 22

#### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. ## August 16 - August 22

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer County) at the Penryn Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight full ramp closures from 8 p.m. Sunday August 16 to 7 a.m. Monday August 17 through 7 a.m. Thursday August 20 for bridge work.

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.







## August 16 – August 22

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from 6 p.m. **Monday August 17 to 6 a.m. Tuesday through 6 a.m. Thursday August 20** for roadway excavation.

#### **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Interstate 80/Hwy 20 junction to the Bear River: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Thursday August 17 – 20 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Illinoistown Overcrossing at Canyon Way and South Auburn Street/Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect freeway connector ramp closures Monday August 17 through Friday August 21 except 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. for paving operations. Motorists can also expect intermittent one-way traffic controls across the Illinoistown Overcrossing 24 hours/day beginning Monday at 12:01 a.m. and ending Friday at 11:59 p.m. for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Monday August 17 through 4 p.m. Friday August 21 for bridge inspection.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Floriston to the Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane, left and right shoulder closures from 6 a.m. to Noon Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for the removal of scaffolding from Acid Flat Bridge.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 5 p.m. Sunday August 16 to 9 a.m. Monday through Thursday August 20 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect daytime and overnight alternating lane closures from 6 p.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 17 through Saturday August 22 for pavement repair.







Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 11 p.m. Sunday August 16 to 5 a.m. Monday August 17 and 11 p.m. Monday August 17 to 5 a.m. Tuesday August 18 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Nevada County) between the Truckee River Bridge and Hinton Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures starting 7 p.m. Sunday August 16 until Noon Monday August 17 and 7 p.m. Monday August 17 through Noon Tuesday August 18 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect right full ramp closure from 7 p.m. Tuesday August 18 to 5 a.m. Wednesday August 19 through 4 a.m. Friday August 21 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Hirschdale Road to the Acid Flat Bridge: Motorists can expect overnight alternating lane and shoulder closures from 7 p.m. Wednesday August 19 to Noon Thursday and 7 p.m. Thursday through 9 a.m. Friday August 21 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Kingvale overcrossing: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 7 p.m. Monday August 17 to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday August 21 at midnight for highway construction.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Yuba Gap Overcrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect right lane, right and left shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for drainage repairs.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Yuba Gap Overcrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and both right and left shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for drainage repairs.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from the Blue Canyon Road undercrossing to the Whitmore Maintenance Station: Motorists can expect right lane, right and left shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for shoulder work.







**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to SR 49 / SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane and shoulder closures from **10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 16 through Sunday August 23** for grinding and paving work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 16 through Sunday August 23** for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 16 through Sunday August 23 for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the Highway 49 and Brewer Road junction: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday August 16 through Friday morning and 8 p.m. Friday August 21 to 8 a.m. Saturday August 22 for striping operations.

**State Route 49 - Southbound** (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect overnight right lane and right shoulder closures from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday August 16 through Thursday morning August 20** for pavement work.

**State Route 49 - Northbound** (Placer County) at Bell Road: Motorists can expect overnight right lane and right shoulder closure from **8 p.m. Thursday August 20 to 5 a.m. Friday August 21** for utility work.

State Route 49 - Southbound (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 for maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Sleighville Circle: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 6:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday August 17 through Friday August 21 for AC paving work.







State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Perry Creek (Sierraville) to Berry Creek (Sierra/Plumas county line): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday August 17 through Friday August 21 for drainage work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday August 17 through Thursday August 20 and 5 a.m. through 2 p.m. Friday August 21 for AC paving and guardrail repair.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road to SR 89/49 junction Sierraville: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday August 18 and 19** for drainage cleaning.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday August 17 – 21 for utility work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Armes Lane to the Newcastle Tunnel: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday August 19 for tree work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
