# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, August 23 – August 29

#### **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. ## August 23 – August 29

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

## August 23 – August 29

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from **6 p.m.** 







Monday August 24 to 6 a.m. Tuesday through 6 a.m. Thursday August 27 for roadway excavation.

### **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Illinoistown Overcrossing at Canyon Way and South Auburn Street/Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect freeway connector ramp closures Monday August 24 through Friday August 28 except 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. for paving operations. Motorists can also expect intermittent one-way traffic controls across the Illinoistown Overcrossing 24 hours/day beginning Monday at 12:01 a.m. and ending Friday at 11:59 p.m. for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Monday August 24 through 4 p.m. Saturday August 29 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) between Floriston and the Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 6 a.m. to Noon Monday August 24 through Thursday August 27 and from 5 a.m. to 11 a.m. Friday August 28 for the removal of scaffolding from Acid Flat Bridge.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge #13 to the Union Mills overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 24 through Saturday August 29 for pavement repair.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Truckee River Bridge and Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 5 p.m. Sunday August 23 to 9 a.m. Monday August 24 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Floriston Road interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 7 p.m. Monday August 24 to 5 a.m. Tuesday August 25 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 6 p.m. Monday August 24 to Noon Tuesday August 25 for striping operations.







Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Floriston to Hirschdale Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday August 24 through Friday August 28 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from Nyack Road to Drum Forebay: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 24 through Thursday August 27 for maintenance work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) through the Chain-Off Area east of the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wednesday August 26 for shoulder work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Soda Springs Off-Ramp: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 5 p.m. to 11 a.m. Monday August 24 through Friday August 28 for highway construction.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to SR 49 / SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane and shoulder closures from **10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 23 through Sunday August 30** for grinding and paving work.







**State Route 49** (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 23 through Sunday August 30** for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 23 through Sunday August 30 for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the Highway 49 and Brewer Road junction: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday August 23 through Friday morning and 8 p.m. Friday August 28 to 8 a.m. Saturday August 29 for striping operations.
