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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, September 6 – September 12

Roadwork will end, project schedule permitting, at Noon Friday September 4 and will not resume until 8 p.m. Tuesday, September 8 for the Labor Day Holiday

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. More information on the project is available at www.raise80.com

<u>September 6 – September 12</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work. (Labor Day holiday restrictions in effect)

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer County) from the New England Mills overcrossing to the Weimar Cross Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating median, lane and shoulder closures from 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. Wednesday September 9 through 8 a.m. Friday September 11 for bridge inspection work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR







89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

<u>September 6 – September 12</u>

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel and right shoulder closures from 5 a.m. to 10 a.m. Wednesday September 9 through Friday September 11 for concrete pour.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Tuesday September 8 through 8 a.m. Saturday September 12 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) between Floriston and the Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 5 p.m. to Noon Wednesday night September 9 through Friday Noon September 11 and from 5 p.m. Friday to 11 a.m. Saturday September 12 for bridge painting (Acid Flat Bridge).

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from the Hirschdale Road exit to Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from 5 a.m. Wednesday September 9 to 5 a.m. Thursday September 10 and from 5 a.m. to Noon Thursday and Friday September 10 and 11 for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from the I-80/Highway 89 junction to the Trout Creek undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane, auxiliary lane and right shoulder closures on **Wednesday September 9 from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.** for shoulder work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 5 a.m. to 11 a.m. Thursday and Friday September 10 and 11 for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp 24-hour closure from 5 a.m. Wednesday September 9 through 5 a.m. Thursday September 10 for miscellaneous work.







Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Hinton Road to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 5 a.m. Wednesday September 9 to 5 a.m. Thursday September 10 and from 5 a.m. to Noon Thursday and Friday September 10 and 11 for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to the SR 49/SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday September 8 through Sunday September 13** for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday September 8 through Sunday September 13 for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday September 8 through Sunday September 13 for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday September 8 through Sunday September 13 for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs to Filippini Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic operations from **6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Tuesday September 8 through Friday September 11** for drainage work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Perry Creek (Sierraville) to Berry Creek (Sierra/Plumas county line): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday September 9 through Friday September 11 for drainage work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. Wednesday September 9 through 2 p.m. Friday September 11 for AC paving work.







State Route 193 (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday September 9 through Friday September 11 for utility work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Dow Road to the end of the passing lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wednesday September 9 and Thursday September 10 for shoulder work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
