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## Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, September 13 – September 19

### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. #### September 13 – September 19

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work. (Labor Day holiday restrictions in effect)

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

#### September 13 – September 19

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel and right shoulder closures from **5 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday September 14 through Friday September 18** for concrete pour.



### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Monday September 14 through 8 a.m. Saturday September 19** for bridge work.

**Interstate 80** – (Placer/Nevada County) from the Yuba Gap Overcrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, right and left shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday September 14 through Thursday September 17** for drainage repairs.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge #12 to the Floriston exit: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from **7 p.m. Sunday September 13 through Noon Friday September 18** for miscellaneous work.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) at the Floriston interchange: Motorists can expect on and off ramp closures from **5 a.m. Tuesday September 15 to 5 a.m. Wednesday September 16** for miscellaneous work.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp 24-hour closure from **5 a.m. Tuesday September 15 through 5 a.m. Wednesday September 16** for miscellaneous work.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) from Floriston to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **5 a.m. Monday September 14 to 5 a.m. Thursday September 17 and from 5 a.m. Thursday to Noon on Friday September 17 - 18** for miscellaneous work.

**Interstate 80 - Westbound** (Nevada County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to Floriston: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures overnight from **6 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday - Monday September 13 & 14 and Tuesday – Wednesday September 15 & 16** for maintenance work.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) from the Donner Pass Inspection Area/CHP Scales to the Donner Pass Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday Wednesday** for grinding operations.



**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) at 5 Truckee exits (Overland Trail, Hwy 267, Hwy 89N, Hwy 89S, Central Truckee): Motorists can expect on and/or off ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday September 16 and Thursday September 17** for emergency pavement repair.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Placer County) from the Gold Run overcrossing to the Magra overcrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday September 16** for guardrail and culvert repair.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Placer County) at the Monte Vista interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday September 15 and Wednesday September 16** for guardrail repair.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Placer County) from Cisco Grove to the Gold Run overcrossing: Motorists can expect lane, shoulder and median closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday September 14 and Wednesday through Thursday September 16 and 17** for maintenance operations.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to the SR 49/SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday September 14 through Sunday September 20** for pavement work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 13 through Sunday September 20** for pavement work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 13 through Sunday September 20** for pavement work.

**State Route 49 - Southbound** (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect overnight right lane closures from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday September 14 through Friday September 18** for pavement work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday September 13 through Thursday September 17** for miscellaneous work.



**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Perry Creek (Sierraville) to Berry Creek (Sierra/Plumas county line): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Sunday September 13 through Friday September 18** for drainage work.

**State Route 89** (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday September 14 through 1 p.m. Friday September 18** for AC paving work.

**State Route 89** (Nevada/Sierra Counties) from Sage Hen Road to the Little Truckee River: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday September 14 to Thursday September 17** for shoulder work.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to the Hwy 89/49 junction: Motorists can expect alternating lane and right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday September 16 and 17** for tree work.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road to the Cold Creek Campground: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday September 14 through Thursday September 17** for shoulder work.

**State Route 193** (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday September 14 through Friday September 18** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
