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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, September 20 – September 26

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. September 20- September 26

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and onramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work. (Labor Day holiday restrictions in effect)

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the New England Mills overcrossing to the Weimar Cross Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating median, lane and shoulder closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 20 through Friday September 25** for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel and right shoulder closures from 5 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday September 21 through Friday September 25 for miscellaneous work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures beginning at **7 p.m. Sunday September 20 and continuing until 11:59 p.m. Friday September 25** for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line at Kingvale to the Donner Lake Undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. eastbound Wednesday September 23 and westbound Wednesday September 23 and Thursday September 24 for shoulder work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Blue Canyon Road undercrossing to the Nyack Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane, median and shoulder restrictions from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. eastbound Tuesday September 22 and Wednesday September 23 and westbound Wednesday September 23 and Thursday September 24 for tree work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Sunday September 20 through 8 a.m. Saturday September 26 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Maple Street eastbound onramp and the Nevada Street/Hwy 49 westbound onramp: Motorists can expect full connector ramp closures from **11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (eastbound) and 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.** (westbound) **Tuesday September 22** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) at the State Route 20 junction:
Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday September 21 for sign work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Nevada County Line at Yuba Gap to the Kingvale undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and right





shoulder closures from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Tuesday September 21 and 22 for guardrail work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday September 23 for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday September 21 for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from the Gold Run overcrossing to the Secret Town overcrossing at Magra: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday September 21** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Donner Pass Inspection Area/CHP Scales to the Donner Pass Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday September 21** for paving operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at 5 Truckee exits (Overland Trail, Hwy 267, Hwy 89N, Hwy 89S, Central Truckee): Motorists can expect on and/or off ramp closures from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday September 21 and Tuesday September 22 for emergency pavement repair.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Bennett Street/Idaho Maryland Road interchange: Motorists can expect westbound off ramp closure 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. and eastbound on ramp closure 11:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday September 24 for sign replacement.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Lone Grave to Scotts Flat Road (5 Mile House): Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **9 a.m. to Noon Wednesday September 23** for sign replacement.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to the SR 49/SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures as well as moving closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 20 through Sunday September 26** for pavement work and striping operations.





State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 20 through Sunday September 27 for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday September 20 through Sunday September 27 for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs to Filippini Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic operations from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday September 21 through Friday September 25 for drainage work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday September 21 through Thursday September 24 for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 - Southbound (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect overnight right lane closures from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday September 24 through Friday September 25 for pavement work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday September 21 through 1 p.m. Friday September 25 for AC paving work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to the Hwy 89/49 junction: Motorists can expect alternating lane and right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday September 23 and 24 for tree work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road to the Cold Creek Campground: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 7a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday September 21 to Thursday September 24 for shoulder work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
