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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, October 25 – October 31

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. October 25 – October 31

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

October 25 – October 31

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS



Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Truckee River (Acid Flat Bridge) to the Boca Bridge/Hirschdale Road: Motorists can expect right lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday October 27 through Thursday October 29** for pavement work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada County) from the Donner Park overcrossing to the WB Vista/Observation Point: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday October 26** for survey work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) from the Donner Lake Interchange to the Yuba Gap overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating right and left lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday October 26 through Thursday October 29** for guardrail repair

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Drum Forebay overcrossing to the Whitmore maintenance station: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday October 27** for tree work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada/Placer County) from the Yuba Gap overcrossing to Donner Lake Road: Motorists can expect left and right lane and right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday October 26 through Thursday October 29** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Blue Canyon Way undercrossing to the Nyack Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect left (#1) lane, left shoulder and median closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday October 26 through Thursday October 29** for tree work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Cisco overcrossing to the eastbound off ramp to the Rainbow Bridge from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday October 27** for bridge work.

State Route 20 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Bennett Road off-ramp and Tinloy Way: Motorists can expect the ramp's left turn lane and left lane onto Tinloy to be closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday October 26-30** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs to Filippini Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic operations from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday October 26 through Thursday October 29** for paving operations.



State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Lime Kiln Road to Auburn Road: Motorists can expect overnight intermittent alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Thursday October 29 through Saturday October 31 at 8 a.m.** for guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder overnight closures from **7 p.m. Sunday October 25 to 5 a.m. Monday through 5 p.m. Friday October 30** for pavement work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Heesche Avenue to Cemetery Alley: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday and Tuesday October 26 – 27** for drainage cleaning.

State Route 49 (Placer County) at Luther Road: Motorists can expect closure of right turn lane from WB Luther Road to NB Hwy 49 from **7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday October 19 through Friday October 30** for curb/gutter/sidewalk work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) at Bell Road: Motorists can expect right turn lane closure from Bell Road to NB Hwy 49 from **8 p.m. Thursday October 29 to 5 a.m. Friday October 30** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley Road (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday October 26 - 30** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday October 26 through 2 p.m. Friday October 30** for AC paving work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Perry Creek (Sierraville) to Berry Creek (Sierra/Plumas county line): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday October 26 and Tuesday October 27** for drainage work.

State Route 174 (Placer/Nevada County) from the Hwy 174/I-80 junction to Powerline Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls and right shoulder closures from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday October 29** for drainage work.



State Route 174 (Nevada County) from the Brunswick Road to Meadow Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls and right shoulder closures from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday October 29** for landscape work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Hwy 20/Front Road to Oak Street: Motorists can expect overnight one way traffic controls and right shoulder closures from **8:00 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday October 27 through Saturday October 31** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
