LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. November 22– November 28

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.



State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

November 22 – November 28

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) from North Long Ravine Union Pacific overcrossing to Magra overcrossing (Rollins Lake Road): Motorists can expect right lane closures from **7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday and Tuesday, November 23 & 24** for tree work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Newtown Road to Lowden Lane: Motorists can expect alternating lane, median and right shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday and Tuesday November 23 & 24** for drainage work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) at the Luther Road and Hwy 49 intersection: Motorists can expect intermittent southbound turn lane to Luther Road closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Tuesday November 23 and 24** for pavement repair.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Somerset Drive to Rattlesnake Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Tuesday November 23 and 24** for utility work.

State Route 174 – Westbound (Nevada County) from WB Hwy 20 front road/ramp to Ophir Street: Motorists can expect overnight local cross-street left lane closures and detours to Bank Street from **6 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through 5 a.m. Wednesday November 23 - 25** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
