Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, December 13 – December 19

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. December 13 - December 19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) from North Long Ravine Union Pacific overcrossing to Magra overcrossing (Rollins Lake Road): Motorists can expect right lane closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday December 14-17 for tree work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer County) from Bowman undercrossing to Hallborn (Werner) Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect overnight alternating lane and shoulder closures from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Wednesday and Thursday December 16-17 and from 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. Friday through 10 a.m. Sunday December 18-20 for sign work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Cemetery Road, Sierra City: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday December 14-18 for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 – Southbound (Nevada County) from Combie/Wolf Road to Bell Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday December 14-18 for utility work.

State Route 20 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the WB off-ramp to Bennett Street to the Hwy 174 junction: Motorists can expect the ramp's left turn lane and one lane on the surface street to be closed from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday December 14-18 for utility work.

State Route 174 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Memorial Lane to Race Street: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday December 14-18 for utility work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect alternating lane and right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday December 14-16 for utility work.
