# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, December 20 – December 26

Due to upcoming Christmas and New Year holidays, lane closures will not be allowed during the following days and hours:

Christmas:	From:	Thursday	0600 hrs	12/24/2015
	To:	Sunday	2200 hrs	12/27/2015
New Year:	From:	Thursday	0600 hrs	12/31/2015
	To:	Sunday	2200 hrs	01/03/2015

Exceptions may be granted on a case by case basis depending on the work, route or emergency needs.

## LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. #### December 20 – December 26

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and onramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work. (Holiday restrictions on closures apply.)







**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the "Mousehole" project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

#### December 20 – December 26

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) from North Long Ravine Union Pacific overcrossing to Magra overcrossing (Rollins Lake Road): Motorists can expect right lane closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Wednesday December 21-23 for tree work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer County) from Auburn Ravine overcrossing (Forest Hill) to Hallborn (Werner) Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect overnight alternating lane and shoulder closures from 9 p.m. Saturday December 19 to 10 a.m. Sunday December 20 for sign work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
