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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, February 7, 2016 – February 13, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. February 7 – February 13, 2016

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) under the Newcastle Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight alternating lane closures from **10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Friday February 5** as well as subsequent overnight lane closures from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday night through Thursday night until April 30** for bridge work (except Sunday February 7).

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Newcastle Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures to Interstate 80 from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday February 8 through Friday February 12 until 7 a.m. Saturday February 13** for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a



pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

February 7 – February 13, 2016

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the intersection with Harmony Road: Motorists can expect lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday February 9 & 10** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) along the Wise Canal (south of Luther Road): Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday February 8-12** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Dry Creek Road to Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday February 8-12** for maintenance operations.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Kemper and New Airport Road to Cottage Drive: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday February 8-12** for utility work.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer County) from the Hinton Road undercrossing to the Truckee River bridge #13: Motorists can expect right lane restrictions **Wednesday February 10 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) at the westbound I-80 ramp for the Hirschdale/Boca Bridge interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday February 9** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to the Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect left lane closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday February 10 & 11** for bridge work.





Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) from North Long Ravine Union Pacific overcrossing to Magra overcrossing/Rollins Lake Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday February 8-11** for tree work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from the Gold Run overcrossing to the Magra overcrossing/Rollins Lake Road exit: Motorists can expect right lane restrictions from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday February 8** for bridge work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
