Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, March 20, 2016 – March 26, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. March 20 – March 26, 2016

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Newcastle Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures to Interstate 80 from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday and until 7 a.m. Saturday March 26** for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lager Beer Viaduct to .35 miles north of Lager Beer Viaduct: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. until May 6** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Boca Bridge/Hirschdale Road interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday March 24** for guardrail repair.





Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from the 80/267/89 separator to the Fibreboard undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday March 22** for guardrail repair.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from the Little Truckee River Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday March 23 and 24** for crack seal operations.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the junction with SR 174 to the WB off ramp to Bennett Street: Motorists can expect left turn lane on the off ramp and lane one of the surface street closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday March 21-25** and overnight closures from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday March 21 through 5 a.m. Saturday March 26** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Rams Horn Campground to Sidehill viaduct: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday March 21 to March 25** for guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday March 21 to March 25** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 174 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Ophir Street to Memorial Lane: Motorists can expect alternating lane one way traffic control and right shoulder closures on the local cross streets from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday March 21 to March 25** for utility work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
