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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, April 17, 2016 – April 23, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. April 17 - April 23, 2016

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and onramp closures from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lager Beer Viaduct to .35 miles north of Lager Beer Viaduct: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. until May 6** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the junction with SR 174 to the WB off ramp to Bennett Street: Motorists can expect left turn lane on the off ramp and lane one of the surface street overnight closures from **6:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 18 through Wednesday April 20** for utility work.







State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 18 through Thursday April 21 for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 – (Placer County) from Millhouse Drive to Birchville/Tyler Foote Road: Motorists can expect lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 18** for crack seal operations.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound – (Nevada/Placer County) from Camp Spaulding to the Kingvale undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 18 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound – (Nevada/Placer County) from Kingvale to the Yuba Gap overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday April 20 to 21 for drainage work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound – (Nevada/Placer County) from Donner Lake Interchange to Kingvale undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday April 19 for striping operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound – (Nevada/Placer County) from the I-80/Rte. 89S junction to CA Agricultural Inspection Station: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday April 19 for striping operations.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sagehen Creek Road to the Little Truckee River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday April 19 to 21** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 174 – Northbound (Nevada County) from Ophir Street to Central Street: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures on the local cross streets from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday April 18 to 22** for utility work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Lane to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday April 18 to 22 for highway construction.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
