Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, April 24, 2016 – April 30, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. April 24 – April 30, 2016

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lager Beer Viaduct to .35 miles north of Lager Beer Viaduct: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. until May 6** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the junction with SR 174 to the WB off ramp to Bennett Street: Motorists can expect left turn lane on the off ramp and lane one of the surface street overnight closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday April 25 through Friday April 29** for utility work.





State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Elm and Fulwiler Avenues to Persimmon Terrace: Motorists can expect intermittent full highway closure by CHP between **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday April 24** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday April 25 through Friday April 29** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Lower Little Truckee campground to Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday April 27 & 28** for crack seal operations.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to Rice Canyon Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Friday April 25, 26 and 29** for crack seal operations.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sulphur Creek Road to Plumas County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8 a.m. to 4p.m. Wednesday April 27** for core drilling operations.

State Route 174 – Northbound (Nevada County) from Ophir Street to Central Street: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures on the local cross streets from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday April 25 to 29** for utility work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Lane to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday April 18 to 22** for highway construction.

State Route 193 (Placer County) Clark Tunnel Road to Whittington Drive: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions from **8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday April 25 to 29** for utility work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
