Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, June 19, 2016 – June 25, 2016

4th of July Roadwork Restrictions

Interstate 80 – 5 a.m. Thursday June 30 through 8 p.m. Tuesday July 5

All Other Routes – 5 a.m. Friday July 1 through 8 p.m. Tuesday July 5

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. June 19 – June 25

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge and paving work, specifically Horseshoe Bar, Penryn and Newcastle Road ramps. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn, Newcastle and Magra overcrossings for bridge and paving work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Newcastle: Motorists can expect overnight alternating ramp closures from **9 p.m. Sunday June 19 to 7 a.m. Monday June 20**



for paving work. Additional nighttime lane restrictions on the overcrossing will occur as paving is completed.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

June 19 – June 25

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the summer** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from Route 174/80 Separator to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight, alternating lane, shoulder and median closures from **7 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday June 20 through 8 a.m. Friday June 24** for K-rail installation.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) south of Indian Valley Road: Emergency roadwork will be closing one lane from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. until September 23** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Heron Road to Heesche Avenue: Motorists can expect intermittent, 24-hour one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday June 20-23 and Friday June 24 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.** for culvert repair.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Highway 20 junction to South Fork Yuba River Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent, 24-hour one way traffic controls for lane, shoulder and median closures from **6 a.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday June 20-23 and 6 a.m. Friday June 24 to 7 a.m. Saturday June 25** for paving and striping operations.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Indian Valley Campground to Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for right lane closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday June 20-23** for ditch cleaning.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Camp Pendola Road to Sierra County Line: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **midnight to midnight Monday through Tuesday**





June 20-21 and from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday through Friday June 22-24** for emergency culvert repairs.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Hinton Road undercrossing to Floriston off-ramp: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday June 21** for hazmat cleanup.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Sierra County line to Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday June 20-23** for slide removal.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Placer County line to Yuba Gap overcrossing (Hwy 20 separator): Motorists can expect right lane closures from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Wednesday June 20-22** for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from just north of Sage Hen Road to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect intermittent, 24-hour one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 7 a.m. Monday June 20 through 7 a.m. Saturday June 25** for roadway excavation.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from the SR 49/Sattley junction to Plumas County line: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday June 20-24** for AC paving.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Deerfield Drive to Donner Pass Road: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday June 20-22** for striping operations.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from I-80/Hwy 267 Junction to Rainbow Drive: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday June 20-22** for striping operations.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Road to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic control and right shoulder restrictions from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday June 20 through Friday June 24** for highway construction.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Fowler Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday and Tuesday June 20-21** for utility work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
