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# Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, July 3, 2016 – July 9, 2016

Most traffic-interfering work will be limited through 8 p.m. July 5 due to the Fourth of July holiday weekend.

## SPECIAL EVENT

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Nevada Street to the Downie River: Motorists can expect a moving closure of both lanes from **Noon to 1 p.m. Monday July 4** for the Downieville 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade.

### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. #### June 19 – June 25

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and onramp closures from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday for bridge and paving work, specifically Horseshoe Bar, Penryn and Newcastle Road ramps. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn, Newcastle and Magra overcrossings for bridge and paving work.







**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

#### <u> June 19 – June 25</u>

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the summer** for bridge work.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Placer County) from Route 174/80 Separator to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight right lane and shoulder closures from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Tuesday July 5 through 7 a.m. Friday July 8 for fence work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) south of Indian Valley Road: Emergency roadwork will be closing one lane from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. until September 23** for retaining wall construction.

#### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Highway 20 junction to South Fork Yuba River
Bridge: Motorists can expect alternating lane, shoulder and median closures from 6 a.m. to
7 p.m. Wednesday through Friday July 6-8 for guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Goodyear Creek Road to Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for right lane closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday July 5-7 for miscellaneous work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Battelle Street to Plumas County Line: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for a moving closure **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday July 5-7** for maintenance operations repairs.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Sierra County line to Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wednesday through Thursday July 6 & 7 for ditch cleaning.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Roseville Parkway overhead (between Taylor Road and Galleria Boulevard): Motorists can expect overnight lane closures from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday evening through 7 a.m. Saturday July 9** for bridge work.





**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the connector ramps to/from Highway 65: Motorists can expect alternating full ramp closures from **11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Tuesday night July 5 through 5 a.m. Friday July 8** for paving operations.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Road to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect around the clock one way traffic control and right shoulder restrictions from 6 a.m. to
5:59 a.m. beginning Wednesday July 6 through 6 a.m. Friday July 8 for highway construction.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
