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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, October 30 – November 5, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work is nearly completed on the \$36 million project which increased the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance was increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two had the roadway below dug down. October 30 – November 5

Interstate 80 (Placer County) in a one-mile section under and adjacent to the Brace Road overcrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures as electrical sensors are installed in the roadway. No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

October 30 - November 5

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the summer** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Hwy 174/I-80 junction to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight right lane and shoulder closures from 6 p.m. to 11 a.m. Sunday Oct. 30 through Friday Nov. 5 for roadway excavation.







Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from Hwy 174/I-80 junction to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight moving lane and shoulder closures from 6 p.m. to 11 a.m. Tuesday night through 9 a.m. Friday morning Nov 2-4 for bridge work.

Interstate 80/State Route 20 (Placer & Nevada Counties) from Magra to Kingvale (I-80) and Yuba Pass (I-80/Hwy 20 interchange) to Willow Valley on SR 20: Governor's drought-related state of emergency declaration includes removal of dying, dead and hazardous trees damaged by bark beetle infestations and other drought-related causes. The projects will improve motorist safety, as well as reduce fuel for potential fires.

October 30 – November 5

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada) from Monte Vista overcrossing (Dutch Flat) to Nyack undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane, shoulder and median closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday October & November for tree work.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada) at the Yuba Gap, Crystal Springs, Baxter, Drum Forebay, Blue Canyon and Emigrant Gap overcrossings: Motorists can expect full ramp closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday October 31 to Nov 4 for tree work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Scotts Flat Road to Omega Rest Area: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane/shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday October 31 to Nov. 4 for tree work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Yuba County line to Penn Valley Drive: Motorists can expect overnight moving one way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday night through Friday morning Oct. 30 to Nov 4** for striping operations.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Sacramento Street overcrossing to Uren Street/Hwy 49 junction: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday Oct. 31 to Nov. 4** for landscape work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Camptonville to Carvin Creek Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday Oct. 31 to Nov. 4 for miscellaneous work.









Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Illinoistown overcrossing/Canyon Way to Weimar Cross Road: Motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday Oct. 30 to Nov. 4 for culvert replacement operations.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Rocklin Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect left lane closures from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday Nov 1-2 for median barrier work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Roseville Parkway overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight, alternating lane and shoulder closures on the local cross street from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday Oct. 31 to Friday Nov. 4 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada & Placer County) at various locations: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Friday Oct. 31 & Nov. 1, 4 for electrical work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Gold Run overcrossing: Motorists can expect full eastbound on-ramp closures from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday October 31 to Nov. 4 for roadway excavation.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday Oct. 31 to Nov. 3** for snow pole installation.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) at the Donner Creek and I-80 on/off ramps roundabout: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday Nov. 1-3** for striping operations.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at Rampart, Alpine Meadows, and Squaw Valley highway camera poles: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Nov. 2-4** for electrical work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday Oct. 31 to Nov. 3 for snow pole installation.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Road to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect around the clock, 24-hour one way traffic control and right shoulder restrictions from **6 a.m. Sunday October 30 to 6 a.m. Saturday Nov 5** for highway construction.









State Route 267 (Nevada County) at Truckee Bypass: Motorists can expect right shoulder closure from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday Nov. 1** for electrical work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
