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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, November 13 - 19, 2016

Due to the Veteran's Day holiday on Friday, Nov. 11, most lane closures will not be allowed from 6 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 10 until 8 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 13 (or until 10 p.m. Monday Nov. 14 for Westbound I-80)

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work is nearly completed on the \$36 million project which increased the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance was increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two had the roadway below dug down. November 13-19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) in a one-mile section under and adjacent to the Brace Road overcrossing: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures as electrical sensors are installed in the roadway. No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

November 13-19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the fall** for bridge work.







Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Hwy 174/I-80 junction to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight right lane and shoulder closures from 6 p.m. to 11 a.m. Sunday Nov. 13 through 9 a.m. Friday Nov. 18 for roadway excavation.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from Hwy 174/I-80 junction to Secret Town overcrossing (Magra & Alpine): Motorists can expect overnight moving lane and shoulder closures from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday night through 5 a.m. Thursday morning Nov 15-17 for bridge work.

Interstate 80/State Route 20 (Placer & Nevada Counties) from Magra to Kingvale (I-80) and Yuba Pass (I-80/Hwy 20 interchange) to Willow Valley on SR 20: Governor's drought-related state of emergency declaration includes removal of dying, dead and hazardous trees damaged by bark beetle infestations and other drought-related causes. The projects will improve motorist safety, as well as reduce fuel for potential fires.

November 13-19

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada) from Monte Vista overcrossing (Dutch Flat) to Nyack undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane, shoulder and median closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday October & November for tree work.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada) at the Yuba Gap, Crystal Springs, Baxter, Drum Forebay, Blue Canyon and Emigrant Gap and Secret Town (Magra/Alpine), Monte Vista (Dutch Flat) over/undercrossings: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for tree work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Omega Rest Area to Washington Ridge Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane/shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for tree work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Yuba County line to Penn Valley Drive: Motorists can expect overnight moving one way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday night through Friday morning Nov. 14-18** for striping operations.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Sacramento Street overcrossing to Uren Street/Hwy 49 junction: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday Nov. 14-18** for landscape work.







State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Yuba County line to Gold Lake Road/Greene Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18** for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Illinoistown overcrossing/Canyon Way to Weimar Cross Road: Motorists can expect lane and shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for culvert replacement operations.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Hinton Road to Acid Flat Bridge (Truckee River): Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for pavement grooving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Floriston interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 to accommodate nearby pavement grooving work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Trout Creek undercrossing to WB onramp to I-80: Motorists can expect right lane closures from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday Nov. 16 for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Sierra College Boulevard overcrossing: Motorists can expect shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. from Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for landscape work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada & Placer County) at various locations: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Thursday Nov. 14-15 & 17 for electrical work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Gold Run overcrossing: Motorists can expect full eastbound on-ramp closures from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday Monday-Friday Nov. 14-18 for roadway excavation.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at the Northstar highway camera poles: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday Nov. 14** for electrical work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.
