Lake Tahoe Basin and El Dorado County Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday, December 4-10, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 89 (Placer County): Work is in **winter suspension** on a \$70.1 million project from Tahoma to Granlibakken Road in Tahoe City that is upgrading storm water drainage and treatment systems, adding curb and gutter, resurfacing and realigning the road, adding new left-turn pockets and widening shoulders on an 8-mile stretch of the highway. Completion is expected in summer 2017.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado County) from Skyline/Coon Hollow Road to Chamberlain Street in Placerville: Motorists can expect a full highway closure from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday** for utility work. A detour will be provided.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Cameron Park Drive: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday and 8 p.m. Friday to 8 a.m. Saturday** for bridge work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Red Hawk Parkway: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday and 8 p.m. Friday to 8 a.m. Saturday** for bridge work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Schnell School Road: Eastbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **5 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Thursday** and westbound motorists can expect the #1 lane closed from **10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for bridge work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Carson Road to Sly Park Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect the #2 lane closed at various locations from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday** for tree removal work.





U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Upper Truckee River Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday** for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from the Tahoe City Transit Center to the Pfeifer House: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control and intermittent full highway closures at various locations from **8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Friday** for tree removal work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
