Lake Tahoe Basin and El Dorado County Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday, March 12-18, 2017

EMERGENCY PROJECTS

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County): Motorists can expect daytime lane restrictions in multiple locations from Fresh Pond to Silver Fork from **dawn to dusk Monday through Saturday** for slope repair and drainage work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado/Placer County): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from the El Dorado County line to Tahoe City from **8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to noon** for dead tree removal.

State Route 193 (El Dorado County): Motorists can expects one-way traffic control from Rock Creek Road to the junction with State Route 49 around the clock for slide removal and slope repair work.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 89 (Placer County): Work is in **winter suspension** on a \$70.1 million project from Tahoma to Granlibakken Road in Tahoe City that is upgrading storm water drainage and treatment systems, adding curb and gutter, resurfacing and realigning the road, adding new left-turn pockets and widening shoulders on an 8-mile stretch of the highway. Completion is expected in summer 2017.

State Route 89 (Placer County): Work is **weather dependent** on a \$35 million project in Tahoe City to build a new Truckee River bridge east of the Caltrans Maintenance Yard with roundabouts on either end, replace the existing Truckee River (Fanny) Bridge, construct a roundabout at the "Wye" intersection and make complete street enhancements to the portion of State Route 89/West Lake Boulevard that will become a local road after project completion, which is expected in 2018. State Route 28 (Placer County) from the junction with State Route 89 to Grove Street in Tahoe City: Motorists can expect the auxiliary lane and right shoulder closed **from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday** for utility work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Agatam Avenue to National Avenue: Motorists can expect the auxiliary lane and right closed from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday** for utility work.
